



Arenacross Riders Meeting

Welcome to the Action Sports Arenacross Championship

All riders must attend the riders meeting!!

The following information will help you all of the activities for this event. After you read this entire sheet, if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask. Our entire staff wants you to enjoy the race. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to help. **All rules listed below are for the safety of the riders, spectators and track personal. We appreciate your help.**

- This is an AMA sanctioned event; all riders must have a valid AMA card or current receipt to compete.
- Do not ride your motorcycle anywhere except the race track.
- Look for the practice and race order in our posting area.
- If you have a problem in practice notify a track or staging official before you return to your pit area. We want you to have a complete practice if possible.
- If you are caught in an unauthorized practice you will be disqualified without a refund.
- All minor riders must be at registration with their parents or guardian. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Qualifying

If there are more riders than starting gate positions in any class the riders must ride in a qualifying heat race to transfer to the main event. If the rider does not transfer to the main event from their heat race they can ride a conciliation race or last chance qualifier. Everyone has two chances to qualify for the night's main event.

The number of riders that transfer to the main event from the heat and conciliation races is determined by the number of riders in each class. Each class may be different. All heat races will run in race order as posted. All conciliation races will follow the same order. You can find this info in the posting area.

If there are the same amount of riders or less as starting gate positions, (IF TIME ALLOWS) one heat race will determine the riders gate pick in the main event in that class. Riders are not required to ride this race but will go to the starting line last if they don't.

Start Procedure

The Action Sports card goes up, if you have a problem raise your hand, you will have two minutes to fix it. The card then goes to "1" (we do not stop at this point) the "1" card goes sideways; the gate will drop between 3 and 7 seconds.

ATTENTION!! "C" RIDERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO JUMP THE FINISH LINE TRIPLE JUMP!!!

- Bring a spark plug and wrench to the starting line.
- Red Cross flag: Means you must proceed with EXTREME CAUTION!! There is an injured rider on the track. There is no jumping if the Red Cross flag is out.
- Heed the yellow caution flag. This flag requires you to proceed with caution. There is no jumping or passing between the caution flag and the incident that caused it. Do not take a chance on hurting yourself, another rider or track personal. This will not be tolerated!! Anyone deemed to be riding without EXTREME CAUTION on a Red Cross flag or yellow flag will be docked positions, laps or disqualified!!

- Disorderly or unsportsmanlike conduct on the track, in the pits or anywhere on the facility by a rider, mechanic or family member can result in disqualification and or removal from the facility without refund for all parties involved!!
- It is against AMA rules for a rider or anyone with a rider to drink alcoholic beverages in the pit area.
- In the event that a rider is injured, all riders, family members and mechanics must stay off the track to prevent additional injuries.
- Please exit the track promptly after the completion of your race.
- Paramedics are on duty if medical attention is required at any time. Please make sure all paperwork is completed by the paramedics, especially if you carry Armor Insurance.
- Number changes are very important. Make sure all X's, slashes, and numbers are very plain on all number plates.
- If you have entered to compete for two days and decide not to compete the second day, PLEASE notify registration as soon as possible. A refund for your entry may not be available after the heat races are posted for that day.
- Please make sure you know and use the track entrance and exit as instructed at the mandatory riders meeting.
- Make sure to wear goggles and all safety gear at all times.
- Be on time to staging. If you miss your heat race you must go directly to your conciliation race.
- Only one mechanic or family member will be allowed on the starting line with the rider, NO CHILDREN!!
- Riders must sit in the riders section during the main event at the Huntington event.
- It is the riders' responsibility to sign up in the correct class and to meet all age, class and bike size requirements. If you have questions concerning these requirements please see the AMA rulebook at www.ama-cycle.org for this info. Riders that sign up in the incorrect class intentionally or by mistake are subject to disqualification.
- If you have ever at any track, sanctioned or not sanctioned, competed in a higher rated class than you have signed up for today, you must ride in that class today unless you have petitioned and were granted permission to return to the lower class. Anyone caught riding in a lower class will be disqualified.

If you ride a 150 Honda four stroke motorcycle, regular or big wheel, the only classes legal for you to compete in are the Supermini and Schoolboy classes. These two classes are for riders 12 to 15 years of age. There is no class available to legally ride a 150 Honda if you are under 12 years of age. AMA rules allow a rider under 12 to ride in the 12 to 15 age class but they must continue to ride in that class permanently.
