From Rt 33 Columbus, exit route 682 South The Plains, turn right on 682, Go 3.4 miles, turn right on Vore Ridge Road, go 2.8 miles, turn right on Salem Road, track is 1/2 mile on right.
From Rt 50 Parkersburg, exit route 682 North (exit 17) go 2.8 miles on 682, turn left on Vore Ridge Road, go 2.8 miles to Salem Road, turn right, track is 1/2 mile on right.
From Rt 32 / 50 Cincinnati, exit route 682 North (exit 17) go 2.9 miles, turn left on Vore Ridge Road, 3 miles to Salem Road, turn right, track is 1/2 mile on right. Address: 10700 Salem Rd. Athens, Ohio 45701
The track is extremely fun and at least 10 ft. Wide. Hilly open woods, and rolling motocross sections.
